

Help for Holocaust Survivors and the Hungry



Close to 300 people supported Jewish Family Services' Third Annual *Helping Our Hungry Community event* with special recognition of the Holocaust Survivors Program at the home of Marcia and Alan Lazowski.

The event raised over \$55,000 which directly supports the JFS Anja Rosenberg Kosher Food Pantry and services for its clients. On behalf of the Rosenberg Family, event co-chair Pia Rosenberg Toro expressed, "There are many needs that are dear to our hearts, but nothing is more important to us than children in need, and children that are hungry most of all. We are in awe of the outpouring of support from our community."

"We are so proud of our community's generosity and spirit of giving in this season of miracles. These donations will help tremendously in funding services to Holocaust survivors and the Kosher Food Pantry, as we more than doubled our fundraising expectations to meet basic human needs," explained Judy and David Rosenthal, event co-chairs.

Thanksgiving Bounty

This year's Thanksgiving Holiday Food Bags event, coordinated by the Anja Rosenberg Kosher Food Pantry at Jewish Family Services, attracted more than 30 volunteers. They worked for hours packing turkeys and all the trimmings into bags to be delivered to over 100 Food Pantry clients for Thanksgiving.

The campaign ran for several weeks seeking donations of \$18, paired with in-kind donations from The Crown Market, which were accepted at The Crown and TD Bank,
